As the result of an extensive budgetary process, Norwood-Fontbonne Academy is once again projecting a modest tuition increase – 3.5% which equates into an approximate dollar amount of \$340 per child. It is important to note that the 2010-2011 anticipated educational cost per pupil is \$11,408. If this cost were to be absorbed solely by tuition revenue, the required tuition increase would have exceeded 15.5%. Through the invaluable support of the Annual Appeal and Parents Association, NFA is able to offer this moderate increase.

The enclosures highlight pertinent financial information and specifics for re-enrollment. In order to plan efficiently for staffing and curriculum needs, you are respectfully requested to complete this process no later than February 22.
