The Loft

Purpose: To provide care for children in the Montessori Preschools (3, 4, and 5-year-olds) and for children in the Kindergarten.

Staff: Assigned in accordance with age appropriate adult-child ratio

Calendar The Loft will operate every day that school is in session except when there is a noon dismissal. During the “phase-in” period, the Loft will be available only to students who are registered for the program. Regular Loft sessions will begin on Wednesday, September 15, 2010.

Location: Norwood Campus—Stone House, second floor

Transportation: Children will be shuttled via school van from the Fontbonne Campus to the Loft.
